When business continuity and recovery plans are tested in a realistic environment it is often discovered that significant capability gaps exist when trying to move staff, suppliers and other resources to a recovery centre, which is often obviously, some distance away.

Accommodation, child care, catering along with the ability to communicate between disparate groups whilst en route can create further challenges.

**247i Logistics** can provide the extra support you may need.

**247i Logistics** is a collection of service capabilities that allows organisations to concentrate on their recovery effort knowing that the additional support they need is being taken care of.

**247i Logistics** is not an ad-hoc service, logistics plans are fully detailed by our planning team, tested as required and stood down ready for future activation. Just one call to the 247i Crisis Management Centre activates the plan.

A typical scenario might involve an organisation's recovery team being required at the recovery centre 150 miles away. **247i Logistics** organises taxis to collect them and take them to a briefing centre, usually a local hotel. Catering and briefing facilities are made available before a number of coaches arrive to take them to the recovery centre. Accommodation local to the recovery centre is arranged for all members of the recovery team and a shuttle service between the hotel(s) and the recovery centre activated. When the recovery effort is complete the movement operation is reversed.

Additional services include managed audio/web conferencing providing members of the recovery team with vital time to make informed management decisions whilst en-route to a recovery centre or scene of the incident

Medical repatriation of overseas staff can also be arranged.

In addition to crisis logistics 247i also provide a managed rapid notification service in the form of **247i Messenger** and **247i Roll Call** a managed evacuation service.
